7	grant application	n period shall begin on November 1 of each year and end on January 31. Funding priorities, as
8	determined by t	the Commission, shall be listed on the Commission's website prior to the opening of an application
9	period.	
10	(b) Grant applic	eation submission dates shall be announced on the Commission website, https://www.ncdps.gov/about-
11	dps/boards-and-	commissions/governors-crime-commission/grant-process not less than 90 days before the application
12	is due.	
13	(c) Grant applie	cations shall be electronically submitted to the Commission through the Grants Management System
14	(GMS) on or be	fore the date announced on the Commission website.
15	(d) To be con	sidered for funding, applicants shall complete the grant application, which shall <u>may</u> include the
16	following inform	mation:
17	(1)	names, mailing addresses, telephone numbers, and signatures of the applicant;
18	(2)	project information, including the following:
19		(A) a description of the project, its goals and objectives, and outcomes;
20		(B) the issues or problems addressed by the project;
21		(C) project operation and activities; and
22		(D) a sustainability plan;
23	(3)	a proposed budget;
24	(4)	a project time line;
25	(5)	an explanation of how the project's results will be monitored and evaluated;
26	(6)	any other information required by these Rules or requested by the Section in order to make a decision
27		on the grant proposal; and
28	(7)	a description of how the objectives of the proposed project are consistent with the outcomes and
29		guidelines set forth in a State or federal grant program.
30	(e) Applicants s	seeking funding for a two-year project shall submit the information required by Paragraph (d) with the
31	requirements of	Part (d)(2)(A), Part (d)(2)(C), and Subparagraph (d)(5) written to address the two-year grant period.
32	Applicants shall	also submit two one-year budgets.

4	SECTION .0500 – EXCEPTIONS
5	
6	14B NCAC 05B .0501 WAIVER
7	The Secretary may waive any rule in this Subchapter that is not statutorily required. Factors the Secretary shall use in
8	determining whether to waive a rule are:
9	(1) the need to comply with a legislatively mandated or other off cycle grant;
10	(2) the nonrecurring use of expiring funds;
11	(3) a declared emergency; or
12	(4) when the Commission is acting solely as a fiscal agent.
