Highlight: Kiran supports South Asian victims of domestic violence

Kiran is a non profit organization with the mission to end the cycle of domestic abuse and to serve and empower South Asian victims of domestic violence in North Carolina by providing culturally specific services and comprehensive economic, social and community resources. They currently work with clients from Afghanistan, Bangladesh, Bhutan, India, Maldives, Myanmar, Nepal, Pakistan and Sri Lanka. Kiran's services include a 24-hour crisis hotline, client advocacy, crisis counseling, safety planning, support groups, resource referrals, secondary family services and translation assistance. Kiran partners with local agencies that share a goal to offer comprehensive services for clients and the local community. Last year, Kiran served a record high of 174 in-person clients and answered 3,746 crisis calls.



Through the Violence Against Women Act funding, Kiran is able to engage in outreach and provide cultural sensitivity trainings and services. On August 11, they will hold their annual Kiran Bazaar in Morrisville. Local clothing, jewelry and food vendors sell products at the Bazaar in support of this organization as they serve the South Asian community and strengthen their outreach efforts. 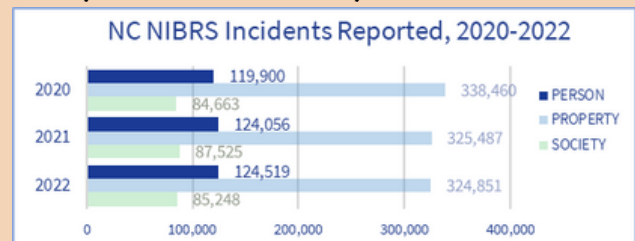
