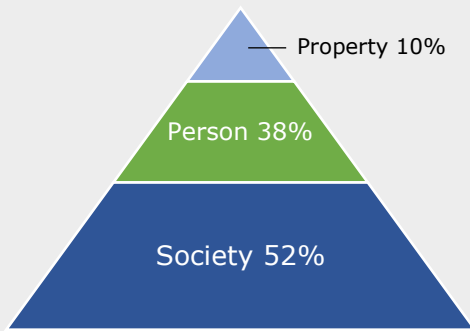


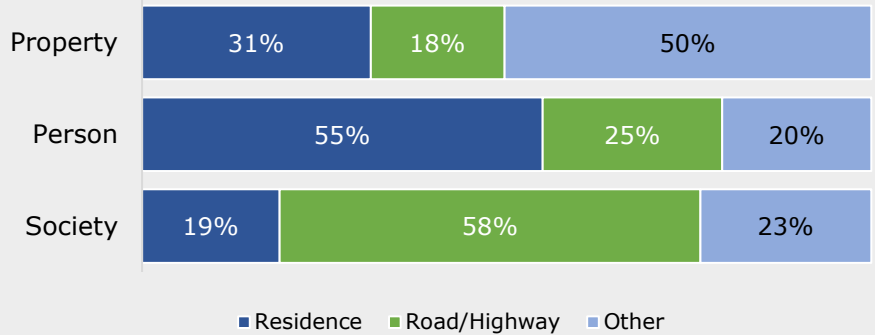
Firearm-Related Offenses in North Carolina in 2021

Of the 509,772 incidents reported to the National Incident-Based Reporting System in 2021, 29,555 (6%) involved a firearm.

Firearm Incidents by Offense Group¹



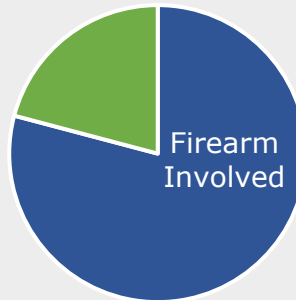
Location of Firearm Incidents by Offense Group¹



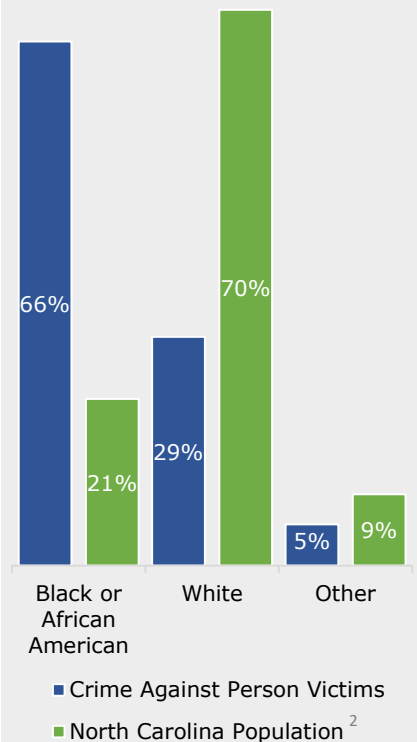
69%

79% of all **homicides** involved a firearm



Crime Against Person Victims by Race



Males made up 58% of firearm incident victims:

70% of Crime Against Property victims were male

56% of Crime Against Person victims were male

Nearly **1 in 5** victims of a Crime Against Person involving firearms was a **juvenile**



¹Offense Groups: Crimes Against Persons (offenses whose victims are always individuals), Crimes Against Property (the object of these offenses is to obtain money, property, or some other benefit) and Crimes Against Society (offenses that represent society's prohibition against engaging in certain types of activity)
