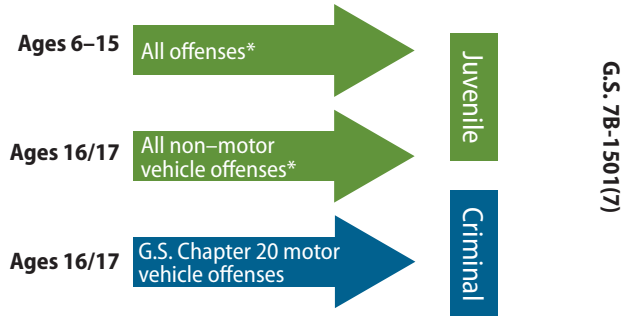


## N.C. JUVENILE DELINQUENCY LAW ENFORCEMENT REFERENCE CARD



\*Any juvenile with a previous criminal conviction, other than a misdemeanor or infraction motor vehicle offense not involving impaired driving, must be processed as an adult. G.S. 7B-1604(b).

**Prior to custodial interrogation of anyone under 18, must advise of:**

1. The right to remain silent;
2. Any statement made can be and may be used against the juvenile;
3. The right to have a parent, guardian, or custodian present during the questioning; and
4. The right to consult with an attorney and that one will be appointed for the juvenile if the juvenile is not represented and wants representation.

These rights can be waived **only** by juveniles age 16 or 17. (G.S. 7B-2101(b))

## **N.C. JUVENILE DELINQUENCY LAW ENFORCEMENT REFERENCE CARD**

### **Fingerprinting and Photographing Juveniles**

#### **Must be done if:**

**G.S. 7B-2102**

- Age 10 or older
- In physical custody of law enforcement
- Complaint is prepared for filing
- Alleged to have committed murder, rape in the first or second degree, sexual offense in the first or second degree, arson, any felony drug offense, first-degree burglary, crime against nature, and any felony that involves the willful infliction of serious bodily injury upon another or that was committed by use of a deadly weapon
- Transferred to SBI only after adjudication for a felony

#### **Must photograph at a show-up if:**

**G.S. 15A-284.52(c1)**

- Age 10 or older
- Alleged to have committed one of the above offenses or common law robbery

**All other nontestimonial identification procedures by law enforcement prior to adjudication as delinquent require a court order**
