In order to assure the best instruction is provided, certain requirements have been established for one to become an instructor for us. All Instructors wishing to teach Incident Command System (ICS) classes for Emergency Management must submit an ICS Instructor application and proof of completion of the minimum requirements. The minimum requirements for an ICS Instructor can be found with the ICS application and detail exactly how to complete the application and submit it. Different pre-requisites that fall in line with Federal requirements have been established to teach ICS classes and therefore the application packet for an ICS instructor differs from a General Instructor.
