INSTRUCTIONS ON HOW TO FILL OUT THIS FORM

1. Type or neatly print your first name, middle initial, last name, suffix, address, telephone number which you can be reached, city, state, postal zip code, and a good e-mail address if you have one. At any time your contact information changes, you must inform NCEM.
2. If you would like to have your contact information shared with academia and State Emergency Response Commission partners, please check “**Yes, ...**” right below your contact information.
3. NOTICE: If you are an ICS instructor certified by NCEM prior to October 2005, you must take the ***ICS Instructor Update Course*** prior to submission of this form. This course is designed to give you the updates to the federal ICS curriculum.
4. Select which category you wish to be an instructor.
 - a. ICS Curriculum Instructor – Teaches all ICS courses in either a lead or unit support instructor role. Attach copies of certificates to the form for review.
 - b. ICS 100 Lead Instructor – Teaches the ICS 100 course in a lead instructor role. Can act in the capacity of ICS 100 unit support instructor.
 - c. ICS 100 Unit Instructor – A subject matter expert that can teach an identified unit within the ICS 100 curriculum only.
 - d. ICS 200 Lead Instructor – Teaches the ICS 100 and 200 courses in a lead instructor role. Can act in the capacity of ICS 100 or 200 unit support instructor.
 - e. ICS 200 Unit Instructor – A subject matter expert that can teach an identified unit within the ICS 200 curriculum only.
 - f. ICS 300 Lead Instructor – Teaches the ICS 100, 200, and 300 courses in a lead instructor role. Can act in the capacity of ICS 100, 200, or 300 unit support instructor.
 - g. ICS 300 Unit Instructor – A subject matter expert that can teach an identified unit within the ICS 300 curriculum only.
 - h. ICS 400 Lead Instructor – Teaches the ICS 100, 200, 300, and 400 courses in a lead instructor role. Can act in the capacity of ICS 100, 200, 300, or 400 unit support instructor.
 - i. ICS 400 Unit Instructor – A subject matter expert that can teach an identified unit within the ICS 400 curriculum only.
5. ICS Education Background – Under each section are blocks for you to check off if you have the courses completed. You must have completed all identified courses under the section you are applying for to be considered to be certified as an ICS Curriculum, Lead, or Unit Instructor. You must attach copies of your certifications to the application form.
6. ICS Experience – Federal requirements mandate that you have applicable real-life experience coupled with an education background in the related subject you wish to teach. You must obtain your supervisor’s signature with he/she attesting that you have the required experience as an Incident Commander or served in a Command or General Staff position as identified under the section you are applying for.
7. Adult Instruction – Federal requirements mandate that each ICS instructor has the education and experience in teaching before being allowed to be certified as an ICS instructor. Identify your appropriate adult education experiences and education in the block provided under the section you are applying for. Attach copies of any certificates, diplomas, degrees, etc. that you have received in adult education.

Once you have completed all appropriate blocks in the section that you are applying for, have attached all copies of your applicable certificates, diplomas, degrees, etc., and had your ICS experience validated by your supervisor, send all documents and this form to:
