BASIC SRO TRAINING

- 40-hour Course
- Triad Concept: Law Enforcement, Educator, Mentor
- Emphasizes the importance of MOU b/t School and LEA
- Recent revisions include addition of content on:
 - FERPA
 - Crisis Intervention
 - De-Escalation Techniques
 - Exceptional Children
 - Juvenile Mental Health
 - Critical Incident Response and Lessons Learned



COMMISSION MANDATES

- Training mandated by both Criminal Justice and Sheriffs' Education and Training Standards Commissions
- SRO = (20 hrs. +/-week)
- Must complete Basic SRO course w/in 1 year of assignment
- Training curriculum 'authored' by NCJA



TRAIN-THE-TRAINER (Basic SRO)

- Must have completed SRO and be GI
- Added TTT component to the Basic SRO curriculum
- Delivered three (3) TTT Courses
- Partnered with Samarcand and Community Colleges
- To date: 116 Officers trained



ADVANCED SRO SURVIVAL

- Decision-making and De-escalation
- Tactical Combat Care (tourniquets and life-saving techniques)
- Use of Simulator - Scenario Training
- Entry and Search Techniques
- Force-on-Force Training
- Training on School Campuses and Buses
