This week at the General Assembly, budget conferees met frequently to resolve the last few discrepancies between the Senate and House budgets. Leadership also met with Governor Cooper this week to discuss his proposal for expanded budget negotiations. The General Assembly is expected to release its budget early next week and present it to the Governor for his signature by week's end.

On Monday, the Committee on Rules, Calendar, and Operations of the House met to discuss two Department of Public Safety bills. Senate Bill 191, *Out-of-State Law Enforcement/2020 Republican Convention*, passed unanimously out of committee and will be heard on the House floor June 25th. House Bill 630, *Private Protective Services/Alarms Systems Law Changes*, underwent a thorough discussion by members and stakeholders, but no vote was taken. The bill will be considered again in a future meeting.

The legislature this week acted on other bills of note for the department as well. The Senate concurred in the House Committee Substitute for Senate Bill 11, *ABC Regulation and Reform*, and the bill was sent to the Governor. On Wednesday, House Bill 283, *Conner's Law*, received a favorable report by the Senate Judiciary Committee and was re-referred to the Senate Committee on Pensions and Retirement and Aging. Additionally, House Bill 99, *Transfer ALE*, passed the Senate by a vote of 47 to 0. The bill will now go to the House for concurrence with the Senate amendment to modify the effective date. Once the House concurs with the amendment, the bill will then go to the Governor for signature.
