This week at the General Assembly, legislators commemorated the 75th anniversary of D-Day by holding session in the State Capitol building. Lawmakers passed a resolution to honor the service and sacrifice of World War II veterans and to remember the North Carolinians who perished during the Normandy invasion.

On Tuesday, the House voted 109 to 1 not to concur with the Senate changes to House Bill 966, 2019 Appropriations Act. As a result, leadership has appointed conferees from both the House and Senate to work through variations in both budgets. During that process, the Department will provide feedback on preferences.

The Senate Select Committee on Prison Safety did not meet this past Monday; however, the meeting has been rescheduled for Monday, June 10th at 3:00 pm. The committee plans to discuss its recommendations.
