	Question	Response
1	<p>The fact that this RFP is only for funding for three months is confusing. Is there any guidance to providing evidence-based services within a 3-month time period, or any understanding about expectations for the proposal based on the limitations of this request?</p>	<p>The Department will be scoring RFPs for this funding source in the same method as previous years. The department would expect to see a program described as if it were being funded for a whole fiscal year, but it may be beneficial to identify steps that can be completed in the first 90 days. The budget should also be for 12 months. The state may post RFPs with limited funding periods identified in order to meet an immediate need but still adhere to legislative funding cycles. The state will pro-rate the awarded 12-month contract to meet the 3 month funding period. RFP responses should meet all requirements of the RFP posting.</p>
2	<p>What is the total amount of funding available for this opportunity?</p>	<p>A funding cap has not been set for this response opportunity; however, Vendor's are encouraged to submit the most cost effective budget for the service they propose.</p>
3	<p>Is there a maximum award amount per application?</p>	<p>There is no maximum award amount for this response opportunity, but Vendor's can utilize previous fiscal year awards to understand the award range that is typical for the department under this award category.</p>
4	<p>What is the allowable Administrative Overhead/Indirect Cost Rate percentage?</p>	<p>No Administrative Overhead/Indirect Cost Rate percentage has been established.</p>
5	<p>What is the total number of youth to be served through this opportunity, annually?</p>	<p>Total number of youth to be served annually through this opportunity should take into account the capacity of the program and the caseload of the program staff according to fidelity to a model or capacity and caseload should be considered in association with targeted outcomes for the evidence supported interventions proposed.</p> <p>Additionally, Vendors responding to this RFP should utilize the data provided in the posting to determine how many juveniles</p>

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		are projected to qualify for the program they are proposing.
6	Wanted to confirm that the time frame is only 3 months? April 1-June 30, 2021? Will there be options for subsequent funding in future program years?	Yes, there will be an opportunity for subsequent funding for awarded gang services under this RFP for FY 21-22, which may include a leadership review for continuation funding under the legislation for two-year funding cycles.
7	Is there any guidance to providing evidence-based services within a 3-month time period, or any understanding about expectations for the proposal based on the limitations of this request?	Due to the time of release of the RFP, the department wishes to award and prorate the funded program for the remaining portion of the current fiscal year in order to meet the immediate programming needs for the identified population. The provider should submit a 12-month budget and anticipate funding for the FY 21-22 in addition to the prorated period of award for FY20-21.
