

Dashboard Tips: 5 Calendar Year Historical Trend

The *5 Calendar Year Historical Trend* dashboard consists of six (6) key juvenile justice system indicators. Each indicator is briefly defined in the bottom left portion of the dashboard. Prior to RtA (Raise the Age), the upper end of original juvenile jurisdiction for delinquency was age 15 at offense. The RtA population displays the number of events where juveniles aged 16 or 17 were charged, diverted, placed on supervision, etc.

To Filter and Interact with the Dashboard (3 Options)

1. **Filter location** by selecting one or more value(s) from the District and/or County dropdown.
 - a. There are thirty juvenile judicial districts in North Carolina. If you know the District, use your mouse to click on the down arrow or in the rectangle next to the word "District".




A screenshot of a dropdown menu labeled "District". The menu is currently set to "(All)".

- b. If you do not know or need the District, you can select the County from the list of North Carolina counties.



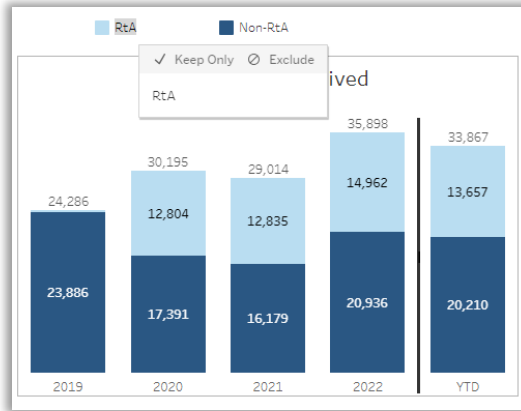
A screenshot of a dropdown menu labeled "County". The menu is currently set to "(All)".



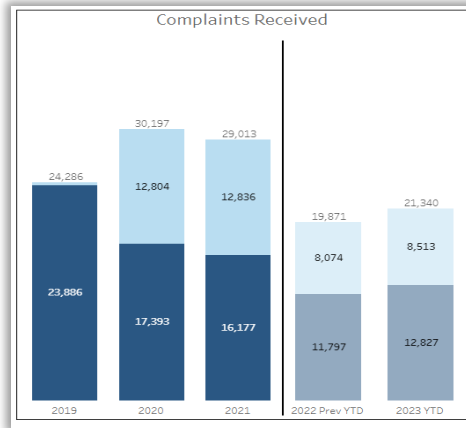

2. **Display age groups** together or individually. By default, the dashboard displays the Non-Raise the Age group ("Non-RtA;" 15 years old or younger) as the darker color on the bottom of the stacked bar in each chart pane, and the Raise the Age group ("RtA;" 16 and 17 year olds) as the lighter-colored top bar. You can display only one group in a pane in two ways.
 - a. In the legend above the pane you wish to edit, left-click the group you wish to keep, and select "Keep Only."

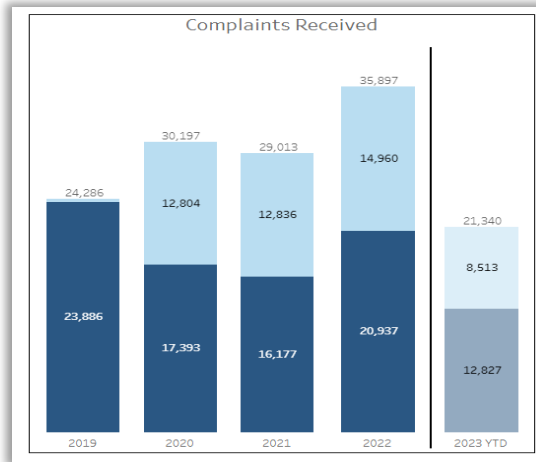
- b. In the legend above the pane you wish to edit, left click the group you wish to exclude and select “Exclude.”



- 3. **Navigate** recent specific time frames using the buttons regarding previous year-to-date (Prev YTD). Within a graph pane, all the bars to the left of the bold vertical line is Year Total, while all the bars to the right is YTD.
 - a. By clicking on the “Show Prev YTD” button, you will be provided with the relative time frame of data from the prior year instead of the prior year total. This will allow you to compare this year to last year for the same time frame.



- b. By clicking on the “Show Prev Year” button, you will return to the view of the full prior year and the partial current year.



To Reset the Dashboard (2 Options)

1. To reset the District or County selections, select the Filter, then “(All)” or Navigation button and the dashboard will reappear as its original presentation.
2. To reset the Age Group and Location selections, select “Revert” in the bottom right-hand corner of the dashboard to return the dashboard to its original state.
